**ORDER**

This is in continuation of Order No. 3PM(COVID)/2020/10056-10105 dated 19.06.2020, 3PM(COVID)/2020/19247-19297 dated 21.08.2020, 3PM(COVID)/2020/19348-19398 dated 28.08.2020, 3PM(COVID)/2020/21554-21604 dated 02.10.2020, 3PM(COVID)/2020/26849-26899 dated 07.10.2020, 3PM(COVID)/2020/ 29295-29345 dated 29.10.2020, 3PM(COVID)/2020/30947-31007 dated 12.11.2020, 3PM(COVID)/2020/33749-33809 dated 09.12.2020 and 3PM(COVID)/2021/33749-33809 dated 08.01.2021; regarding fixation of rates for COVID-19 testing in Haryana State.

2. After due consideration on the matter and advice of experts, taking into account the cost of kits & consumables and on the consensus of leading private labs, the State Govt., in exercise of the powers bestowed under the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, further revises the upper cap of rates for COVID-19 testing as follows:

**Table:1** For RTPCR COVID-19 testing:

S. No.	RTPCR testing	Maximum Charges per test
1	Samples collected at private hospitals/labs and their designated collection centres	Rs. 499/-
2	Samples collected through home visits	Rs. 699/-

**Table:2** For other types of COVID-19 testing

S. No.	Type of COVID-19 Testing	Maximum Charges per test
1	CBNAAT testing	Rs. 2400/- (Already fixed)
2	TrueNat testing	Rs. 1250/- (Already fixed)
3	Rapid Antigen testing	Rs. 500/- (Already fixed)
4	IgG based ELISA testing	Rs. 250/- (Already fixed)

3 It is also directed that that **No private laboratory** should charge any amount more than as mentioned in the tables above for COVID-19 testing, inclusive of GST/Taxes (if any), cost involved in pick-up, PPE, packing, transportation of samples, documentation and reporting, in the State of Haryana.

4 It is further directed that all the laboratories conducting COVID-19 testing must adhere to the guidelines and SOPs as mentioned in the previous orders, and shall follow

all the testing protocols as laid down by ICMR and MoHFW, Govt. of India from time to time.

These orders are issued with approval of Competent Authority and come into force with immediate effect. Non-adherence to these orders may invoke penalty under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
