Dear State Surveillance Officers,

At the outset I would like to appreciate the efforts taken by you in responding to the COVID19 pandemic in your States and Districts. The surveillance for COVID19 in the Country began in the month of January 2020 and has been ongoing since then.


As you all are aware the international passengers' flights for evacuation of stranded citizens from various Countries has been initiated by the Government of India and the first flight has already brought back the stranded citizens into the Country. I would at this point like to reiterate the importance of the surveillance and reporting of these passengers. The reporting of this may be done through the IDSP reporting format - Format C and the line list of these passengers be maintained as per Format B. As this exercise has been performed by all States previously, repeating the same now should not be a problem. The same data should also be uploaded on the COVID19/ Special Surveillance System portal.

The daily report in this regard be shared through email with CSU (idsp-npo@nic.in) before 12 noon along with a copy to the nodal officer at CSU for the State.
